Correction only. The legacy surfaces named below must no longer be read as permission, a training route, an assessment, or evidence of safe navigation. This notice makes no positive efficacy claim and authorizes no publication, deployment, promotion, protocol, guide, or broader book change.

Controlling status

The controlling PWR-078 tier is `T2C__FROZEN_PROVISIONAL_EXPLAINER_CANDIDATE`. Its terminal gate is `HOLD_PUBLICATION`; all eight research branches remain held. PWR-078 is not an operational protocol, a validated public guide, an approved navigation method, or an independently validated capability claim.

Any earlier `PUBLIC_EXPLAINER_READY`, `READY_BOUNDED`, or similar label is an older projection. It does not override the later governed hold. The same is true of a legacy operational label, worked exemplar, evidence grade, measure, level, retention test, transfer test, or protocol-like presentation.

This erratum resolves only that status and safety conflict for readers. It does not alter the bytes of any base edition, close an evidence gate, count as external review, or change the status of any unrelated Titan content.

Reader rule

Where an older Titan surface conflicts with this notice about PWR-078 status, actionability, navigation safety, mobility support, or environmental accessibility, use this notice. Preserve the older text only as versioned historical provenance.

The correction applies to the same inherited family wherever it appears: [MOD-SENSORY-DISCRIMINATION](#) only insofar as it is used for echolocation; the worked exemplar [EX-ECHOLOLOCATION](#); the evidence pointer [EVD-ECHOLOLOCATION](#); the worked-exemplar catalogue entry; and any reader, workbook, index, excerpt, mirror, cache, search result, or derivative display that reproduces or relies on those items.

The machine inventory accompanying this notice records the exact local evidence files, content block identifiers, content hashes, and route anchors used to identify the family. That inventory is verification evidence, not a public claim surface.

What is superseded

For PWR-078 only, the following legacy actionability is withdrawn and superseded:

- any invitation or implied permission to attempt, practise, teach, score, assess, progress, retain, transfer, or operationalize echolocation from the legacy book family;
- any reading of the surrounding module protocol, measures, level anchors, retention language, transfer language, worked exemplar, evidence grade, or catalogue entry as a runnable PWR-078 route;
- any suggestion that the legacy family establishes safe independent navigation, supports removal or reduction of a mobility aid or assistance, or satisfies the later PWR-078 publication gates; and
- any use of the older public-readiness labels as authority for an explainer, evidence summary, guide, protocol, assessment, validation claim, operational promotion, or changed public copy.

Safety restrictions in an older copy continue to apply wherever that copy remains. The generic sensory module is not deleted and may still govern unrelated, separately authorized tasks. [EVD-ECHOLOLOCATION](#) may remain as historical provenance, but it conveys no current permission to act.

Safety and choice boundary

Do not use the legacy family to plan or test movement, blindfolded walking, route travel, road crossing, stairs, water, heights, moving machinery, or any other safety-critical task. Do not remove, reduce, or delay an established mobility support because of it.

Titan does not establish PWR-078 as safe independent navigation and does not advise replacing a cane, guide dog, sighted guide or other live assistance, qualified orientation-and-mobility support, or another mobility method chosen by the person using it. Environmental accessibility is a separate requirement. A person's skill, support choice, or participation does not transfer responsibility for accessible design to that person.

Echolocation is optional. It is not a cure, obligation, test of worth, requirement for independence, or reason to treat blind people as a spectacle or as a single uniform group. This notice contains no exercise, click method, training sequence, route guidance, device procedure, assessment, or recommendation to attempt the skill.

What this erratum does not do

This notice does not endorse or reject an efficacy claim; summarize the evidence; validate a method, person, device, or outcome; modify the base manuscripts; promote PWR-078; revise the wider Operational Standard; authorize reviewer outreach; or release the held PWR-078 explainer. Revision 7K's general Current Edition label, Revision 7L RC2's historical preview lineage, and Revision 7N's general public research-candidate label otherwise remain unchanged.

External advisers are not a prerequisite for this narrow correction-only notice. Their absence is not converted into approval, and this correction does not satisfy the external, affected-party, orientation-and-mobility, accessibility, or other review gates required before any later explainer, training, navigation, assessment, or operational content.

Publication control

The only artifact eligible to become public from this book-erratum package is the exact tagged PDF. The DOCX, source Markdown, machine inventory, technical accessibility report, render record, identity report, release ledger, and build materials are nonpublic evidence.

This PDF is not self-authorizing. Publication requires a separate owner decision made outside the PDF that names its exact SHA-256 and the exact destination.
